

Our Mission

The MSMS Foundation is a non-profit corporation duly chartered in the state of Mississippi to operate exclusively to benefit the mission of the Mississippi School for Mathematics and Science (MSMS). The goal of the foundation is to supplement the funding received by MSMS from the Mississippi Department of Education with other private and public support.

Our History

The MSMS Foundation was initially founded in February of 1989 by a small group of individuals who were passionate about education and improving opportunities for all Mississippians. The original board had diverse backgrounds including education, economic development, and business. They believed the creation of MSMS was an important step in creating educational opportunities in Mississippi, but the next step was to ensure MSMS would have additional support outside of state funding. They established the original charter and bylaws of the MSMS Foundation and envisioned campaigns to raise funds to endow the Foundation. The first board meeting occurred in February of 1989 and in December of 1990 the MSMS Foundation was recognized as a 501c3 nonprofit by the IRS. Today, the MSMS Foundation raises more than \$250,000 annually and helps connect MSMS Alumni and MSMS PLUS to strengthen the MSMS Family.

MSMS Alumni Weekend 2023 celebrated the milestone classes of 1993, 1998, 2003, 2008, 2013, and 2018 in another funfilled weekend with Tales from the Crypt, informational sessions, and a party. The MSMS Foundation supported the revival of the MSMS Senior Celebration. This great event celebrated the Class of 2023's accomplishments and the MSMS Foundation awarded our college scholarships at the event.

Through all of this, the MSMS students, faculty, and staff continue to shine and be amazing. Notable events included MSMS Capitol Day, the Black History Month Program, Business Plan Competition, the Quiz Bowl Team, the VEX Robotics Team, Mu Alpa Theta Convention, and the International Science and Engineering Fair.

The MSMS Foundation stays constant in our intent to support MSMS, the faculty, and the students. We continue to make sure that Mississippi's "Opportunity for Excellence" endures for another generation, and, hopefully, expands to serve more students across Mississippi. A gift to the MSMS Foundation can be designated in one of the following ways:

Excellence Fund

This is the preferred fund for gifts. The Excellence Fund, due to the flexibility, allows for the MSMS Foundation to use donations in areas with the most immediate need. Project examples for this fund include the purchase or repair of laboratory equipment, sponsoring students on summer research projects, renovating computer labs, purchase of textbooks, as well as program support.

Room & Board Assistance Fund

MSMS Alumni and parents started the Room and Board Assistance Fund to help offset the \$1,000 annual Room and Board Fee for students who show financial need. These funds are also used to help assist with required student activity fees. All students are given the opportunity to apply for this assistance each year. The donations to this fund are restricted, so 100% of the funds are used for this purpose.

Summer Camp & AAYME Funds

MSMS conducts Summer Enrichment Camps for middle school and high school students each summer. In 2021, African American Youth in Mississippi Excelling (AAYME) Camp was added to their offerings. The MSMS Foundation provides assistance to students who show financial need. Your gift to this fund helps provide opportunities for students to experience a high-quality academic camp and encourage life-long learning. The donations to this fund are restricted, so 100% of the funds are used for the designated camp.

PLUS Fund

The Parents Lending United Support (PLUS) Fund is a restricted fund used by PLUS. During the school year, PLUS provides direct benefit to MSMS students and faculty. Examples of their projects include exam snacks to students, teacher appreciation events and snacks, Winter Formal decorations and food, Taki Tiki, monthly Lobby Love giveaways and restocking care closets in each residence hall. The donations to this fund are restricted, so 100% of the funds are used by PLUS for these projects.

The Dr. Nancy MacNeill Impact Fund was established in honor of an original MSMS faculty member, Dr. Nancy MacNeill, by her sister Becky Takayesu. It will be fully endowed by 2026 to support the chemistry department and recognize exceptional faculty. The fund's annual earnings will be used to maintain chemistry lab equipment, and it includes the creation of the Dr. Nancy MacNeill Faculty Impact Award, which is chosen by seniors each year and presented during Senior Celebration. The MSMS Class of 2023 chose Mr. Thomas Richardson as the first recipient of this new honor, receiving a monetary award and certificate presented by SGA President Christina Zhang on May 26th.

MSMS Student Competitions and Travel

The MSMS Foundation provides financial support for students to travel to academic competitions each year. Two large student competitions in 2023 were ISEF and VEX Robotics World Competition. Eight students attended ISEF and twenty-two students competed on two teams in Robotics. Madison Echols placed 4th for her research at ISEF, and one of the MSMS Robotics teams placed 9th in the world in 2023, competing with more than 400 international teams.









Georgianna McKenny and Thomas Easterling

MSMS English instructor Thomas Easterling challenges his University Composition students to create original podcasts about their hometowns. Last spring, Georgianna McKenny entered her podcast "How the Jackson Water Crisis Affects Education" into NPR's National Student Podcast Challenge. On June 21, 2023, McKenny's podcast beat 3300 entries and was named the grand prize winner. A few days later, a listener in Ann Arbor, Michigan was so impressed with McKenny's podcast that she made a \$1000 donation to the MSMS Foundation in her honor. 
